(2) DETAILS IF YOU'D LIKE TO PROVIDE EXPANDED CONTENT:

Ever-avid explorers of the sonic landscape, **MadMan3** dances musically around a core of beat-intensive electronica with a studied mix of structure and trancy, textural flights of fancy. They take EDM club fare on a syncopated joy ride off the well-beaten path. These band members hark back to an earlier incarnation that locals will surely recollect: *Ken Sleeps Naked*. But the musical focus has changed. Celebrated for their epic jams, MadMan3 has lately incorporated more ordered segments to artfully bracket all that heady fluidity. They hope, for this event, to have a piece of fresh work to show off that's rumored to have the makings of a new band anthem. **Members:** Fred Wilber: keys; Phillip Bruce

Carr, Jr.; drums; Jofus (*whole name*): Chapman stick, electronics and voice. With special guest vocalist Chris Steller. For observers of instrumental prowess, take note that Jofus taps the 10-stringed, polyphonic chordal Chapman stick like no other. Alt-rock band **Anachronist** is the brainchild of Vermont singer, songwriter, and guitarist Brian Clark, whose original songs generally make up the live playlist. They've been compared to *The Replacements*, *Yo La Tengo*, *Sonic Youth*, *Low*, and *Galaxie 500*. The band's first recording, the five-song *Row* EP, came out in 2012, under the Vermont-based record label State & Main Records. *Seven Days'* senior music scene observer Dan Bolles called their output "work of profound musical and emotional resonance." **Members:** Brian Clark: guitars, vocals; Mike Donofrio: bass; Phil Carr: drums; Craig Jarvis: guitar; Angela Paladino: percussion, vocals. Anachronist will perform songs from their newly released album *Lost in the Corners*. CD's will be available at the concert.

The Flying Stage particularly wishes to celebrate the virtuosity and driving musical influences of drummer Phillip Bruce Carr, Jr. (formerly of *Viperhouse* and *Right Time*, among others), who will perform with both bands. Carr has also been a generous musical mentor to many young people who grew up in our area. (Ed.
